BIG BOPPER JR.: This CD has 13 tracks of his father's songs (Big Bopper's Wedding, Walking Through My Dreams, That's What I'm Talking About, Preacher And The Bear, It's The Truth Ruth, Pink Petticoats, Little Red Riding Hood, Crazy Blues, Monkey Song, White Lightning [the Big Bopper wrote this song and recorded it long before George Jones had his hit with it!], Teenage Moon, Someone Watching Over You, and Chantilly Lace, plus the bonus song of Running Bear [also written by the Bopper] with Johnny Preston doing the background sounds.) Backing Big Bopper Jr. are the Crickets, the Jordanaires, James Burton, the Coasters, and Ace Cannon, among others. His performances are pretty good, really! Jay signed the CD cover in black pen.

CARL BUNCH SIGNED DRUMSTICKS: This is a pair of brand new drumsticks that have been signed by Carl Bunch, who played drums for Buddy Holly and the others on the 1959 *Winter Dance Party* tour, then got frostbite when their bus broke down the day before Clear Lake, Iowa. One stick is signed *Carl Bunch Winter Dance Party 1959*, the other is signed *Carl Bunch "the Frostbitten Cricket"*, so you get two signatures and other handwriting! I know him personally and he signed these in front of me in my home. I'm not sure how long these will be made available so it'll be first come etc. Sent to you in a padded mailer.

JACK NEAL: He was the first to perform with Buddy Holly on Lubbock radio and television. It was Jack who wrote "Modern Don Juan" that Buddy recorded for Decca Records in 1956. This CD has 12 tracks including his own version of "Modern Don Juan". All songs sung by Jack Neal and were recorded in Oklahoma at the studio of Larry Welborn, another person that performed with Buddy Holly in the early days. Jack also plays piano and drums on these tracks, Larry Welborn and Boyd Newton play guitar and bass. This is a home-recorded CD (CD-R) from Jack Neal who owns the music so it is legal to sell. Jack personally signed the cover of this privately-released edition with a green Sharpie. Tucked inside is a special bonus only with these CDs, a wallet-sized picture of Jack Neal in his "younger" days.

BOBBY VEE: This is a real, not digital, 8"x10" color photo of a very young Bobby Vee in 1959 at the age of 16, taken just months after he filled in after the death of Buddy Holly. There is a sticker on the back by the photographer who has copyrighted the photo. You are buying the signed photo only, no rights are given or implied.

Bobby Vee signed a small number of these for me. Yours will be similar to the scan but may not be actual. He signed with a red Sharpie.

SONNY WEST CD: This is a CD single of the two super rockabilly songs recorded by Sonny West in Clovis, New Mexico with Norman Petty in 1956 ("Rock-Ola Ruby" and "Sweet Rockin' Baby"). You don't have to pay over a thousand dollars to get these songs, here they are on this CD, the label of which has been personally signed by Sonny West. According to Sonny, only 800 were made in this limited edition. Sonny also wrote "Oh Boy" and "Rave On" for the Crickets.
